# PRICES REMAINED STRONG AT HART DAVIS HART'S FIRST WINE AUCTION OF THE FALL SEASON ON SATURDAY IN CHICAGO Sale was 99% Sold and Tallied Almost \$4 Million Dollars

(September 18, 2007; Chicago, IL)—Hart Davis Hart launched their fall season in Chicago on Saturday with a highly-charged auction of Finest & Rarest Wines, selling 99% of the lots and posting almost \$4 million in sales. A near capacity room of unusually active attendees competed with absentee bidders from 31 states as well as Brazil, Canada, China, France, Iceland, Japan, Macao, Mexico, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom. The auction was held at highly acclaimed Tru Restaurant.

"We were delighted to welcome a room full of bidders on Saturday and based on the results of the auction we're pleased to declare that the rare wine market remains alive and quite well," commented Hart Davis Hart Vice Chairman Michael Davis.

Classified Bordeaux from top vintages continued a remarkable upward trend, particularly with the best vintages of the past two decades. Interest for these wines reached new heights with dramatic results, such as a double-magnum of Château Lafite 1982 (estimate \$4500-6500) that realized \$10,755, and a case of Château Latour 2000 (estimate \$7500-11,000) that sold to a live internet bidder for \$14,340. The top lot of the day was a case of Château Le Pin 1982 (estimate \$36,000-54,000) that sold for \$50,190.

Burgundy collectors were very active as well, and a rare Methuselah of La Tâche 2000 (estimate \$6500-9500) sold for \$19,120. Also, a three bottle offering of Romanée-Conti 2004 (estimate \$7,000-10,000) fetched \$14,340.

The auction was brimming with rare Californian wines, including a remarkable range of Harlan Estate and Screaming Eagle. Notable results included a single bottle of Screaming Eagle 1992 (estimate \$3500-5500) that sold for \$7767, and a 16-vintage magnum vertical of Staglin Family Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, offered by the Staglins to assist charities, that sold for \$29,875. "This auction was blessed with a plethora of exciting west coast wines for which demand remained consistently strong throughout the day," noted President Paul Hart.
