HART DAVIS HART WINE CO. SELLS OVER \$2 MILLION AT JUNE 24th AUCTION IN CHICAGO

(June 26, 2006—Chicago, IL) With the participation of collectors from 38 states, along with Brazil, Canada, China, Colombia, Germany, Iceland, Indonesia, Japan and Singapore, Hart Davis Hart held a highly successful auction at the Chicago Athletic Association. The auction posted very impressive statistics, with 97% of the lots selling and a total sold of \$2,001,055.

The most exciting single item of the day was a remarkably rare bottle of Romanée-Conti 1934 with exceptional provenance. Estimated at \$4500-6500, the pedigree of the bottle attracted intense interest among international collectors and it sold for \$16,520. "The bottle of Romanée-Conti was truly breathtaking, with an indisputable history," stated Michael View from the Chicago Athletic Association. Davis. "The price achieved was a testament to the importance of provenance."



Among the highlights of the auction was an impressive consignment of large format bottles offered on behalf of Shari and Garen Staglin of Staglin Vineyards (estimate \$62,520-93,180) which brought \$126,909. Most of the bottles were acquired by the Staglins from the Rusty Staub Foundation Charity Auction and the bottles were consigned to Hart Davis Hart in order to raise further funds for the Rusty Staub Foundation. "The Staglin collection created some real excitement, drawing the participation of several bidders on the telephones and in the room" noted Paul Hart. "The bottles were from top estates and in very unusual format, so we were frankly not surprised by the response." Singular results included a Methuselah of La Tâche 1996 (estimate \$10,000-16,000) which brought \$18,880, a Methuselah of La Tâche 2000 (estimate \$4000-6000) that commanded \$10,030, a mammoth Balthazar of Hermitage La Chapelle 2000 (estimate \$3200-4800) which sold for \$12,980, and an exceedingly rare double magnum of Bryant Family 1993 (estimate \$3000-4500) that fetched \$8260.

Classic Bordeaux was highly sought throughout the day, with singular results including two magnums of Cheval-Blanc 1953 (estimate \$3000-4500) that realized \$8850, a case of Cheval-Blanc 1982 (estimate \$6000-9000) which commanded \$11,210, a case of magnums of Leoville-Las-Cases 1982 (estimate \$3200-4800) that sold for \$6490, and a single double-magnum of Lafite 1982 (estimate \$3500-5500) that fetched \$6490.

The release prices of the 2005 futures campaign caused upward pressure on the prices of recent top Bordeaux vintages. The heralded 2000 Bordeaux vintage attracted very strong interest: a case of Latour (est. \$3800-5500) brought \$7080, a case of Lafite-Rothschild (est. \$3800-5500) brought \$6490, and a 6-bottle lot of Margaux (est. \$2200-3200) sold for a staggering \$4720.

"We are preparing for what will be a very exciting Fall season, including the benefit for the Village Foundation to be held at Tru on September 28," said John Hart. "We look

forward to announcing some very exciting collections that are coming onto the market."
